**SCHOLARSHIP FUND**

#### **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of the fund is to provide financial assistance to all qualified staff of the Grace Hospital who wish to further their studies in a course/program relevant to their present position or a different position in the hospital.

#### **SOURCE OF FUNDS:**

The Scholarship Fund was initially set up in 1959. Mr. Jones, who was the first lay member of the Board of the Grace Hospital, recognized the need for the hospital to encourage and assist employees to undertake further studies and thus, made the first contribution.

Donations to the fund are welcome. The fund is administered by The Winnipeg Foundation and earnings on the investments are made available annually for Scholarship grants.

#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR GRANTS:**

To be eligible for educational grants from the Scholarship Fund, the employee must:

- 1) have been employed at the Grace Hospital for more than one year full time, or an equivalent part time. Casual staff are not eligible.
- 2) be prepared to guarantee six months of service to the hospital for substantial grants.
- 3) be registered in the course, have paid the tuition or have completed the course within the past 6 months.

#### **APPLICATIONS:**



All departments will be advised of the deadline date for submission of applications.



Application forms and additional information may be obtained from the Director, Educational Resources.



Applications to the Scholarship Fund are reviewed by the Board of Directors of the fund TWICE YEARLY (Spring and Fall).



Grants are authorized by the Board according to pre-set criteria that relate to:

- value of course to present/future employment at the Grace Hospital.
- quality of job performance.
- length of employment.
- previous grants awarded.
- number of applicants and available funds.
