Dr Hucker will focus on assessment, management, tools, and treatment for clients who have been formally involved or at risk of involvement with the legal/justice system. In light of recent headlines, this topic is particularly relevant. Attendees will also have the opportunity of learning through participation in a multi-disciplinary panel discussion.

About the Presenter:

Dr. Stephen Hucker is a renowned forensic psychiatrist and professor of psychiatry in the Law and Mental Health program at the University of Toronto. Dr. Hucker also serves as a member of the medical staff at the Centre for Addictions and Mental Health (CAMH), in addition to his independent forensic consulting practice.

Prior to these positions, he has served as head at McMaster University in Hamilton, Forensic Division and Program; at Queen's University in Kingston as professor and chair of the division of Forensic Psychiatry; chief of the former Clarke Institute of Psychiatry in Toronto, and the Metropolitan Toronto Forensic Service as medical director.

He has published on a wide range of forensic topics, with more than 80 publications to his credit. His clinical research includes pedophilia and sexual assault, sexual sadism, sexually motivated homicide, and risk assessment/management. Dr. Hucker's expert testimonies are used on a regular basis in both criminal and civil court cases; including dangerous and long-term offender hearings in Canada, sex offenders in a specialized behaviors clinic, and consults to various provincial agencies throughout Canada.
